5 Unchanging Business Principles

Plus: what you can do *this week* to apply them.



1. Obsess over real customer problems

Don't just automate — solve the right problem.

Example: Skip the fancy chatbot. Solve your top 3 customer pain points first.

Action: Interview 5 customers. Ask:
"What's frustrating you most about our service?"



2. Trust is the real currency

AI-generated content is everywhere. But trust comes from transparency.

Example: Share how your team uses AI — and where humans take the lead.

Action: Update your About or FAQ to show how AI supports (not replaces) people.



3. Deliver consistent value, not just novelty

Tools evolve. Value sticks.


Example: Canva wins by staying useful, not just adding AI features.

Action: Audit your offer. What keeps customers coming back? Invest in that.



4. Human judgment still matters

 AI gives data, not decisions.

 **Example:** Netflix uses AI for recommendations — but humans still curate featured picks.

 **Action:** When reviewing AI reports, ask:
"What's the story behind this number?"



5. Relationships over transactions

🤝 AI can write intros. It can't build real trust.

💡 **Example:** Cold outreach with fake personalization still feels cold.

✅ **Action:** Add a personal note. Follow up with a voice message or real invite — not just a link.
